- Some people refuse to celebrate Easter
- traditions
- known as Semana Santa (Holy Week)
- brotherhoods' processions /prəˈseʃ.an/
- The atmosphere that characterizes / kær.ək.tə.raɪziz/ the festivities is usually solemn / spl.am/
- To have strong religious beliefs
- Catholic holiday / kæθ.al.ik/
- the festivities begin on Palm Sunday (Domingo de Ramos) and last until Easter Monday (Lunes de Pascua), with the most dramatic and passionate parades held on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday.
- thousands of pilgrims that gather here from all corners of the world to witness the city's extravagant pasos /Ik stræv.a.g.nt/
- A paso is an enormous float adorned with life-size wooden statues of biblical characters, designed especially for religious processions.
- Each movable float belongs to a brotherhood, or cofradia
- A team of costaleros convey the pasos on their necks and shoulders through the crowded streets
