STATING PREFERENCES

- As far as I'm concerned...
- On the whole, I'd rather + infinitive
- X appeals to me more than Y

SLIGHT DISAGREEMENT

- I'm not very keen on that idea
- I can't go along with that
- To be honest, that's not how I see it.

STRONG DISAGREEMENT

- I totally disagree with that
- I couldn't disagree more
- That's completely unacceptable

PARTIAL AGREEMENT

- Possibly, but...
- Fair enough,

AGREEING

- I have no problem with that
- Sounds good
- Fine by me

INTERRUPTING

- Could I just say something here?
- Sorry, can I come in here?
- May I add something

CORRECTING SOMEONE

- Sorry, I think you have misunderstood me
