There are different structures used to make suggestions in English. These are the most common:

• Why don't + we/you/They+ verb in the Infinitive

Ex: Why don't we go to the cinema?

Why don't they study together?

• Why doesn't + he/she + Verb in the Infinitive

Ex. Why doesn't she buy that dress?

• Would you like +To infinitive?

Ex: Would you like to have dinner in that new restaurant?

• Shall I/we+ infinitive?

Ex: Shall we go to that new restaurant?

• Let's + verb in the infinitive

Ex: Let's go to the cinema!

• What about + Vb ing


Ex: What about ordering a pizza?
