1. The school year ends on 21st June
By the end of June, **the school year will have ended.**
2. It's cloudy today. The weatherman predicts no change for tomorrow (GOING)
It's cloudy today. The weatherman predicts that there's not going to be any change tomorrow. /It's going to be the same tomorrow.
3. I started working here nearly 10 years ago, in February 2002.
By February 2012,**I'll have worked /I'll have been working here for 10 years.**
4. My son has got an appointment at the dentist next Friday afternoon (IS).
My son is going to the dentist next Friday afternoon
5. The rink opens at 7.00 pm and I want to skate for about two hours. (BE)
Between 7.00pm and 9 pm, **I will be skating.**
6. Mr Smith is due to retire from his teaching job in August.
By the end of August, **Mr Smith will have retired from his teaching job**
7. What do you think of his chances of success in his new job?
Do you think he will succeed in his new job?
8. I'm going to play tennis from 2.00 pm until 4 pm today.
At 2.30 pm today , **I'll be playing tennis.**
9. I'll send out all the invitations before lunchtime.
By lunchtime,**I'll have sent all the invitations.**
10. When you visit us, we'll have moved into our new house. (BY)
We'll have moved into a new house,**by the time you visit us**
