EXPLAINING PAST CONTINUOUS

INTRODUCTION. Ask students to look at you and mime an action for 15 seconds or so (writing, cleaning etc). Stop the activity and ask students: What was the teacher doing? Write their answers on the board.

Ask students, to think of a time from the day before, for example 7.00 p.m. Call on different students to ask each other what they were doing at that time.

 MEANING AND USE. Describe a scene to demonstrate the meaning and use of the Past Continuous. Tell the students that the class as a whole is going to write a story but first they must set the scene.

Together, choose a place (a park on a windy day, a crowded party, a haunted house at night...). Tell the students that to set the scene you are going to describe everything that was happening as the story began. Give them a sentence to start. (It was a dark and stormy night. It was a big.) Call on a volunteer to continue with one sentence (The wind was blowing...). Write their sentences on the blackboard.
